

INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Knowlton Township Committee will receive sealed bids for Catch Basin Project involving 7 catch basins on Hemlock Road in Knowlton Township, Warren County, New Jersey.

Work includes one new CB and pipe, replace two CB and pipe, replace four pipe and install new four CB

All awards will be based on a lump sum basis.

Bids will be open and read at the Knowlton Municipal Building, 628 Route 94, Columbia, New Jersey, on May 16, 2019, at 1:00 p.m. prevailing time.

Specifications and forms of bids for the proposed work, prepared by Rodman Associates, and approved by the Knowlton Township Committee have been filed in the office of the Township Engineer, Rodman Associates, 19 Main Street, P.O. Box 647, Blirstown, NJ 07825, and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours. Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Specifications on proper notice and payment of \$25.00 for the cost of the standard proposal forms in the manner designated therein and required by the specifications. All bids must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, bearing the name of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside, and addressed to:

Work can begin immediately, weather permitting and must be substantially complete by August 15, 2019

Bids must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and must include or be accompanied by:

1. Bid Form
2. Company Information Sheet setting forth names and addresses of all stockholders or partners who hold more than 10% or greater interest, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2.
3. Non-Collusion Affidavit.
4. Complete List of Subcontractors set forth company names and addresses, owners, phone and fax numbers.
5. Certificate of experience listing all similar projects
6. Contractor's references, five (5) required. Provide project description and Client (include contact person and phone number).
7. Affirmative Action Statement.
8. Surety Company Certification
9. Bidder's Check List (BCL Form 1, 2, 3, 4).

Contracts for work under Bid will obligate the Contractor and subcontractors to comply with the Revised Statutes of New Jersey, Chapter 127 – P.L. 1975 “Law Against Discrimination: and Chapter 150 (1963) “Prevailing Wages on Public Contract.” Contracts will further obligate the Contractor to only use domestic materials for this project, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52: 53-1 to 4.

Bids may not be modified after submittal. Bidders may withdraw Bids anytime prior to Bid opening.

Knowlton Township Committee reserves the right to waive any informalities in or to reject any and/or all Bids, as may be deemed to be in its best interest, except as may be otherwise mandated by State Law.

The Contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the lowest responsible Bidder or as otherwise provided in N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-37.
