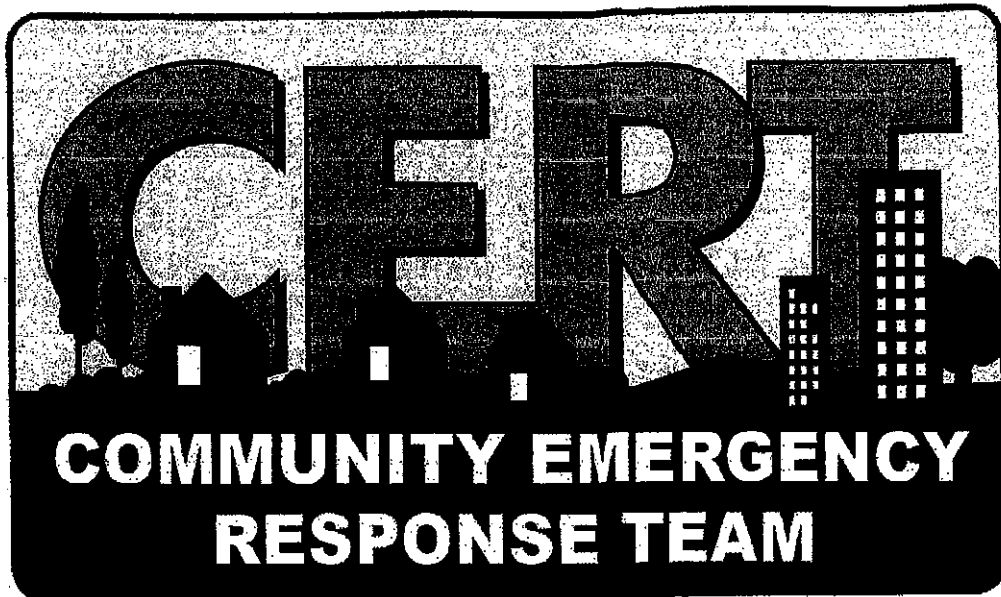

## What Is CERT?

A Community Emergency Response Team is a ready group of organized and trained volunteer disaster workers that operates at the neighborhood level.



The CERT Program prepares volunteers with 20 hours of classroom and hands-on training.

The training is provided by volunteer "subject matter" experts such as firefighters, EMTs, and building safety personnel.
