Other Planning Board Business:

Ordinance 2020-01

The Board reviewed recently adopted Ordinance #2020-01. The Board questioned the zones this Ordinance would impact and there were several comments on the definitions/wording (fuel dispensing systems instead of pumps, etc...) It was agreed to review and discuss the Ordinance and possibly provide Planner and Board input after the Board finishes with the Master Plan.
